Noun	Name of a person, place or thing
Adjective	Describing word e.g. beautiful, yellow, horrible
Verb	Doing or being word
Adverb	Adds more detail to the verb e.g. carefully, luckily, suddenly, very, extremely
Connectives	And, so, because, so that
Alliteration	e.g. the dangerous dragon danced, the slimy snake slithered
Similes	e.g. as cool as a cucumber, as sharp as a knife
Expanded noun phrases	e.g. lots of people, plenty of food
Generalisers	e.g. most dogs, some people
Apostrophe	Can not becomes can't using an apostrophe to highlight where letters have been removed to create a shortened version
Prepositions	e.g. along, behind, above, between
Suffix	One or more letters or sounds added at the end of a word to modify the word's meaning
Prefix	One or more letters or sounds added at the beginning of a word to modify the word's meaning
