Organisation of Classroom for learning

- Grouped for Literacy and Numeracy and Spellings by ability
- Friendship groups for subjects such as Art
- Mixed ability groups for subjects such as Science and History and certain Literacy activities
- Learning styles groups

- Success criteria set for Literacy and Numeracy units of work on board

Reading and Library books

- Reading books will go home every day. Re read book or break longer books into two sessions
- Please sign and write comment. What will you write?
- Other activities with reading book e.g. draw story or chapter as a storyboard, write or tell another story for the main character
- Books changed 3 times a week
- (Mon, Wed, Fri unless daily reader)



Reading and Library books

- Children will read individually to an adult at least once a week (some daily readers). They will read to me every other week.
- They will also read to an adult in a small group of guided reading each week (teacher or TA)
- Reading instructions etc. every day!
- Library books Friday!

Curriculum This Term



What does your child need at school?



- **PE kit (black shorts, white T shirt, plimsoles that fit, sweat top and bottoms in colder weather)**
- **Always have a coat at school**
- **Hat and scarf in cold weather**
- **Sun hat in hot weather**
- **Reading folder every day**
- **Library folder once a week**
- **Don't need water bottle. Children fill up each day themselves. Bottle home for washing every Friday**
- **Nature table**

Homework



- **Read every night.**
- **Homework sheet each Friday. One week to complete**
- **Other homework such as selecting books or finding out about something or someone. Hobby/class talks**
- **Spellings once a week (test on Fridays) Spelling book for home**

Helping your child

- Number bonds to 10,20 or even 100!
- Multiplication tables 2x,5x and 10x minimum requirement of Year 2 then 3x, 4x 6x
- Read and write days of the week, months of the year and their name and address
- Make sure they know their birth date too!
- Count up to 100 and back
- Provide a suitable environment and quality time to do homework together
- Talk about things!
