SUMMER UNIFORM

They need suitable plimsoles for outdoor PE sessions, black **football style** shorts and a T-shirt in house colours for the Juniors and white T-shirt for the Infants. Please make sure all your children's clothes are labelled with their name.

Also make sure all children have a water bottle for the Summer term which will enable them to have a drink whenever they wish.
